## Rocinante

Our 2017 Rocinante is our second Rocinante label, a Spanish-inspired wine dedicated to the work-horse in all of us.

Aged for 17 months in 8% new and 92% neutral French oak, this wine was bottled aged for 9 months before being released.

With hints of black pepper, real black licorice, dried cherry, and ripe Italian plum (like the fragrant plum trees that line the Juliaetta-Kendrick bike trail) on the nose, this light-bodied wine carries flavors of pie cherry and tarragon.

This wine received a Gold medal at the WinePress Northwest Wine Invitational.
