## Syrah

2019 was a bit milder in terms of heat than the preceding 2018 vintage. A long, wet spring paved the way for a delayed yet moderately warm growing season. Large canopies helped maintain a normal grape-ripening schedule, which was crucial when an early October frost cut the growing season short. Bold-flavors, soft tannins, and balanced acids make this vintage one for the books.

Grown on the Clearwater banks of our Arrow Junction Vineyard block, our 2019 Syrah has notes of smoked pork belly, allspice, nutmeg, mesquite ash, raspberry, and Italian plum.
