The cold, wet spring of 2019 was followed by a summer just warm enough to perfectly ripen grapes in the Northwest. While an early October frost cut the harvest season short, the flavors in our 2019 vintage are incredible. Our last single varietal Merlot was released in 2012. When the growing season allows, we like to bottle a bit of this grape on its own. Red berry notes, subtle earthiness, moderate acidity, and soft tannins.
