Syrah

The 2020 vintage was relatively normal, with moderate yet consistent temperatures and only a few days of extreme heat exceeding 100°F. Excessive ground moisture prolonged the need to irrigate until midsummer. September wildfire smoke delayed ripening and harvest a bit, but a long, frostfree fall brought everything to ripeness. Yields were low in 2020. Berry size was very small, concentrating flavors and colors in the red grapes. A smaller production with huge potential.

Grown on the Clearwater banks of our Arrow Junction Vineyard block, our 2020 Syrah has a nose of Moroccan spice, floral and earth notes. This lighter bodied wine embodies dark fruits such as blackberry and boysenberry. Bright and clean, the acid balance in this Syrah is spot-on and makes it the perfect pairing for your food table.
